The University has a large number of bars, cafés and shops selling 'food on the go' across campus; serving students, staff and visitors to the University.

The main catering facilities are located in the Staff House (number R24 on the university campus map) and are open to everyone. They include Bratby Bar (Ground Floor), Café Aroma (First Floor), Noble Room (Second Floor) and Astor Restaurant (Third Floor). [Avanti](#), University Centre (number R23 on the campus map), Ground Floor:

A 160-seat restaurant that provides a wide range of fast foods including breakfast, traditional snacks, pizza, confectionery and drinks; also houses a deli bar and a salad bar.

[Café Go](#), University Centre (R23), First Floor:

A sandwich shop providing hand-made deli sandwiches to order while you wait; also selling pastries, speciality coffees and a wide range of drinks and confectionery.

[Cyber Go](#), Arts Building (R16), Ground Floor:

A coffee shop located in a new computer cluster, providing a large range of speciality coffees, sandwiches, confectionery and cakes.

[Go 2](#), Learning Resource Centre (R28), Ground Floor:

Based on the same specification as the original *Go*, this sandwich shop sells sandwiches, pastries, speciality coffees and a wide range of drinks and confectionery.

A coffee shop providing a large range of speciality coffees, sandwiches, snacks, confectionery and cold drinks.
