Problems and Choices

CLASH #1: 1B cannot be scheduled in an appropriate slot for students on the Bsc/MSci Pure Maths & CS.

Solution: if 1B is split, then most joints + MatEng take the version in L2 joint slots, single honours and PM&CS take in L3 joint slots.

CHOICE #1: 2B scheduled either compatible with Math Eng (Tues 14-19 or Fri 14-18) or compatible with Bsc/MSci Pure Maths & Comp Sci (We 9-11, Thu 9-10, F r 9-10).

CHOICE #2: 201 either scheduled compatible with TPAM/BNatSci (Maths&Phys) (Wed 9-11, Thu 9-10, Fri 9-10) or compatible with MathEng (Tu 14-19, Fri 14-18).

CHOICE #3: The four L3 joint slots at Wed 9-11, Thu 9-10 and Fri 9-10 are required for three modules:

2B if Bsc/MSci Pure Maths & Comp Sci is chosen above MathEng

2D for Bsc/MSci Pure Maths & Comp Sci

201 for TPAM and BnatSci with Maths&Phys (if chosen above MathEng)

CHOICE #4: At level 3, is the exclusion between Applied Maths II and Number Theory OK?

CHOICE #5: should 3P06/3P07 (combinatorics/logic, computability/coding theory) best be grouped with 2B or 202?

For information: the following groups can be made inside the third year slots. modules within a group cannot be taken together in the same year.

The following groupings are possible (should be enforced?)

2B (3G03) grouped with 3P06/3P07 (?) and 3A03

2D (3G05) grouped with new 3M.. (which incorporates 2Da)

201 (3A02) grouped with 3A05 and 3P05

202 (3S02) grouped with 3P06/3P07 (?) and 3A04

203 (3P04) grouped with none.
